San Antonio universities designated as 'Military Friendly Schools'

Four institutions of higher education in San Antonio have been named to **G.I. Jobs'** 2010 list of Military Friendly Schools.

The **University of the Incarnate Word, Baptist University of the Americas, San Antonio College** and **Wayland Baptist University** have all been recognized by the magazine for their practice of embracing America's veterans as students. All the schools on the list have a priority of recruiting students with military experience.

G.I. Jobs listed the top 15 percent of colleges, universities and trade schools. Schools on the list offer benefits to student veterans such as on-campus veterans programs, credit for service and military spouse programs. More than 7,000 schools nationwide were polled to compile the list.
